Ancient Civilisations

Geography/ History

English

Maths

This term the children will be studying non-unit fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, measuring time as well as reading digital and analogue time, angles, shapes as well as position and direction and area. As well as this they will use all these topic areas to solve problems and develop their reasoning skills. The basic skills will be revisited every day to ensure that they are remembered too.
