

### Ways to help your child...

We are sending home weekly reading books, please read with your child and record this in their reading records.

Your child will have termly homework challenges, try to complete one of these per week, any log-in details should be found in your child's reading record.

### History and Geography

In History we discover the past by looking at objects like the Bayeux Tapestry. This will help us learn about William the Conqueror; Henry VIII, Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria, Elizabeth II.

We will link our History and Geography units, finding the location of important places and historical buildings.

### Science

Our science focus this term is plants. We will learn about what plants need to grow and thrive as well as how they reproduce. In the next half term we will look at animals and their life cycles.

### RE / PHSE

In PHSE we will look at safely managing risks. Next half term we will be looking at how to create a healthy lifestyle.

In RE, we will be exploring the joy the Torah brings to the Jewish Community and in the second half of the term we will look at what Jesus taught about God in parables.

### The Arts

In art we will explore how painters sometimes use paint in an expressive and gestural way. Exploring colour mixing and experimental mark making to create an abstract still life.

In DT we will learn about constructing towers and strengthening materials for a given purpose.

In music we will be learning a new song and using pianos to accompany the song.

### English

In English, we will be learning how to write instructions learning how to write our own instructional text.

Later in the term, we will look at the adventure story, The Owl Who Was Afraid Of The Dark by Frank Cottrell Boyce and write our own adventure story.

### Maths

We will begin this term continuing our work into fractions, finding unit fractions by division.

We will then be looking at measurements; length, mass and time.

In the next part of the term we will look at the composition and comparison of 2D and 3D shapes.
