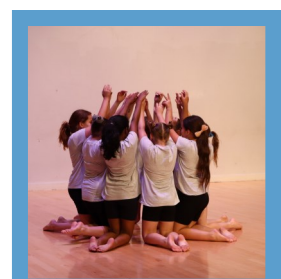
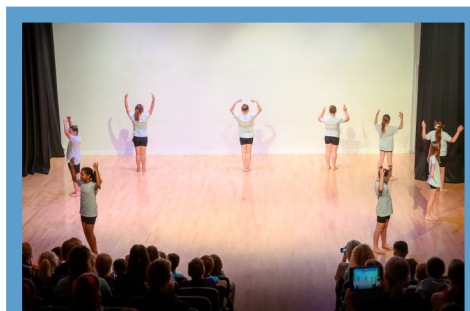
For now, I wish you all a lovely summer break and look forward to see our children back with us on 4th September.

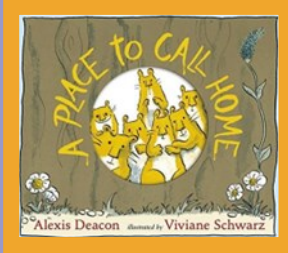
