Happy Valentines Day! Do you know some of the traditions from around the world? In Denmark friends exchange cards with white flowers called snowdrops while in Ghana 14th February is National Chocolate Day. In Wales people exchange handcrafted spoons and in Bulgaria couples celebrate with a glass of local wine. However, the tradition I like most is one from Estonia where they celebrate Sobrapaev or Friendship Day. Family members and friends exchange gifts to celebrate. Friendship and support is so important and is one of the characteristics we focus on in our wellbeing curriculum. As part of our PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education) staff regularly explore with our children how we can be good friends with each other and treat each other with kindness through our words and our actions, just as everyone would like to be treated.





As well as support for our children, we do run a weekly coffee and catch up session for parents on Wednesday afternoons at 2.30pm. It is a chance to drop in and meet with other parents for a cup of tea or coffee along with Leanne, our student social worker. Our international coffee and catch up group also runs on a Friday at 2pm. Leanne will be there to help with any questions about school processes or paperwork that you might have. Everyone is welcome.

If your child cares for, or is affected by, a family member who has a physical disability, a long-term physical illness, a mental health illness or a dependency on drugs and/or alcohol, then they are a Young Carer. They do an amazing job and could be eligible for extra support from Suffolk Young Carers to have a break from their caring role and to have fun through clubs and activities. 


