#### SEND News from Mrs Wakeman

This week I would like to signpost you to a useful course on the SENDIASS website.

Booking is open for an online session, hosted by SENDIASS, where specialist teachers from the Social, Emotional and Mental Health Service will explore ways to help children and young people to understand and manage their feelings.

Supporting children and young people to manage their emotions 17 July 2025 (10am – 11:30am)

The presentation will be delivered by specialist teachers from Suffolk's Social, Emotional and Mental Health Service. This is one of the five Specialist Education Services (SES) in Suffolk, which support schools to support pupils with different special educational needs.

- The session will explore:
- what your child's behaviour may be communicating
- strategies to support your child

• what can lead to meltdowns and how to support your child during and after a meltdown

• strategies learning settings can offer and advice they can access to help your child with understanding and managing their feelings and behaviour. You do not have to use your video or speak in the session if you'd rather not - you can just listen or use the chat.
