

Ways to help your child...

We are sending home weekly reading books, please read with your child and record this in their reading records.

Your child will have termly homework challenges, try to complete one of these per week, any log-in details should be found in your child's reading record or homework book.

RE / PHSE

In RE we will be asking the Big Question 'How does believing Jesus is their saviour inspire Christians to save and serve others?'

In PSHE we will be learning about Beginning and Belonging. We will use stories, games and discussions to learn about feelings, building relationships and coping with new situations.

Science

We will be learning about light and shadows: identifying light sources, investigating reflective materials and carrying out shadow investigations.

After half term, we will be learning about the human skeleton and making comparisons to other animal skeletons.

Maths

In maths we will be revisiting place value and partitioning numbers and exploring numbers on a number line. We will then move on to representing, comparing and ordering numbers to 1,000.

English

We will be writing our own story based on 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs' by Jon Scieszka. During this unit the children will use a range of sentence starters and learning to use a wider range of punctuation, including commas and inverted commas.

Afterwards, we will be learning to write instructions based on 'My Strong Mind' by Niels Van Hove. The children will learn to use a range of precise imperative verbs to describe actions. They will learn how to use bullet points and brackets to structure their non-fiction writing.

Geography

We will be developing our understanding of significant locations in the UK and comparing these to settlements on a contrasting location, New Delhi. We will be developing our geographical skills, through using maps to identify human and physical features of landscapes.

The Arts

In art, we will continue our storytelling creating transforming a 2D character from a story into a 3D clay sculpture.

In DT, we will look at food from different cultures and create our own lovely lunch.

In music this year, we have 2 specialist teachers who will be teaching students the ukelele.
