

Ways to help your child...

Read with your child. They may not be ready to read by themselves, but it is so beneficial for an adult to read to them on a regular basis.

Every time you read with your child, or they read to you, write it in their reading record. Four entries in their reading record means they will get a ticket to put in the reading award jar.

Science

Children will understand how to identify if something is alive by using the 6 life processes check list.

We will also be learning about a range of different habitats.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at the United Kingdom and identifying the 4 countries that are part of it, along with their capital cities.

We will also be learning about the weather in the UK and how we prepare for weather changes.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the Muslim faith and how important compassion is in our everyday lives.

Art / DT

The focus in art watercolours. We will be introduced to the artists Paul Klee and Emma Burleigh. We will then develop skills to build imagery through water colours.

English

In English, we will be looking at a recount text style of writing before moving on to an information text. This text will relate to habitats around the world which links in with our Science this term.

Maths

This term the children will continue with their addition and subtraction of numbers within 10, leading on to factor families. Year 2's will be focussing on the addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers and will begin to work on multiplication. These skills will be revisited every day at the start of the lesson to help the children remember what they have learnt.

Music

Following the Charanga Music programme we will be focussing on exploring sounds. Once we have explored these sounds we will be creating our own very simple melodies.
