

Ways to help your child...

Read with your child. They may not be ready to read by themselves, but it is so beneficial for an adult to read to them on a regular basis.

Every time you read with your child, or they read to you, write it in their reading record. **Four entries in their reading record means they will get a ticket to put in the reading award jar.**

Science

To identify parts of minibeasts and group accordingly.

We will also look at the micro habitat they live in and how they survive.

At the end of the topic we will be looking at what a Botanist is.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at the United Kingdom. We will be looking at the countries that make up the UK and the seas and oceans that surround it.

We will then be gathering data on our coast and how people use it, after which we will present our findings.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the Jewish faith answering the question: Why is the Torah such a joy for the Jewish Community?

Art / DT

We will start by looking at a range of books that contain sliders and levers and discussing how they work. The final piece of work will be a picture containing sliders or levers.

English

In English, we will be looking at a poem called 'If I were in Charge' which will no doubt give rise to a lot of discussion. After this we will be watching an animated clip about the sea from which we will be writing our own narrative.

Maths

This term the Year 1 children will be working on numbers up to 20 looking at addition and subtraction, 1 more and 1 less and number bonds. Year 2s will be continuing their times tables with a focus on 5s and 2s. We will also revisit previous learning to help the children remember what they have learnt.

Music

Following the Charanga Music programme we will be focussing on pulse, rhythm and pitch.
