

Ways to help your child...

Read with your child. They may not be ready to read by themselves, but it is so beneficial for an adult to read to them on a regular basis.

Every time you read with your child, or they read to you, write it in their reading record.

Four entries in their reading record means they will get a ticket to put in the reading award jar.

Science

To research the habitat of the Ocean. We will be looking at rock pools (micro habitat), life cycles of creatures you find in the ocean, the impact of litter on their habitat, as well as the Oceans food chains.

History

In Geography we are initially focussing on how we learnt to fly and the famous inventors involved. We will then be looking at significant people related to flight.

Art / DT

We are looking at flora and fauna. We will be drawing from a film after which we will use graphite and oil pastels, with the final piece being the creation of a minibeast collage.

RE

In RE, we will be learning about Parables and the stories relating to God.

Maths

This term the Year 1 children will be counting up to 100, compare numbers and identify 1 more and 1 less. Year 2's will be finishing the year by looking at division, fractions and statistics. We will also revisit previous learning to help the children remember what they have learnt.

Fridays is also Maths Scrapbook day. Each week Year 1 and 2's will bring their scrapbook home with a new task to be discussed in class the following week.

Music

Following the Charanga Music we will be playing instruments with singing and listening being at the heart of each lesson.

English

In English, we will be reading The Storm Whale. We will be looking at language features to use in our writing before producing our own piece of independent writing at the end of the term.
